



VIP Tagging Services Contract

Please read the following, check the appropriate boxes, sign, and date. Contact Emily at 405-740-9357 or Emily@monkeybusinessok.com to set up an appointment to deliver items to be tagged.

1. All items should be free from stains, rips, pet hair, and should not be out of date. Any items found that do not meet this requirement will be donated and will not be returned to the consignor.
2. Any item that requires batteries should have batteries and be tested to make sure it works before sending with VIP Tagging coordinator. Any items without batteries and/or not in working condition will be donated and will not be returned to the consignor.
3. All items (especially toys) should be checked for recalls at www.cpsc.gov. Any items found that have been recalled will be disposed of and will not be returned to the consignor.
4. All items should be freshly laundered and folded in boxes. If you wish for specific items to be matched as a set, please fold those items together.
5. You will be charged a 50/50 split for VIP Tagging Services versus the standard 70/30 split. The standard \$10 consignor fee will be deducted from your check as well as \$10 for tagging supplies (i.e. hangers, pins, etc.).
6. All items will be donated to local non-profit organizations to be determined by Monkey Business Children's Consignment Sale. You will not receive a receipt for items donated as we do not ask for receipts when items are donated.
